

## Public Law Outline

### Information for Parents about Court Proceedings

#### Introduction

Children and Family Services has significant concerns about the welfare of your child

- Attend the meeting that has been arranged

#### Your child's social worker is responsible for:

- Producing a plan that ensures your child is safe and has the benefit of a stable and secure future
- Arranging a meeting with you and your solicitor to discuss Children's Services concerns about the welfare of your child, and
- Identifying what needs to change to improve things for the better

#### What happens next?

Your social worker has arranged a meeting with you and your solicitor to:

- Clarify the concerns of Children's Services
- Agree what supports you may need in order to make changes to prevent going to court
- Identify any members of your extended family who able to offer support to you and your child
- Identify any members of your extended family who could care for your child if you are unable to do so

#### What you need to do next:

- Contact a solicitor – a list has been attached to the letter
- Identify family members
- Confirm with your child's social worker that you will be attending the meeting

#### What will happen if you do nothing?

Children's Services will consider taking immediate legal action which could include the removal of your child

#### Who to contact if you do not understand what is happening:

You should make contact with your child's social worker immediately. If they are not available you must ask to speak with their manager
